Activity Instructions

Crate stacking

Equipment

- 1 ladder
- 6 safety hats
- 1 safety rope
- 2 karabiners
- 2 climbing harness
- 1 control device
- Lots of crates

Check equipment against this at the start and end of your session and report anything missing or broken. Check chains, steering, tyres and general condition before use

People

- 1 on crates
- 3 to 5 to pass crates
- 1 Adult belaying

Leader requirements:

A Leader who can belay is required but no formal permits needed. One competent person must take overall charge of the activity and ensure the equipment is in good order and used in a safe manner. Damaged safety equipment must be removed from service and a



replacement obtained before the activity continues.

Guide to use of equipment:

Only one person climbs by stacking the crates higher and higher with other team members throwing the crates up to them. The person on the crates must be belayed by a competent person as shown in the picture.

The ladder is to retrieve the thin ropes from high in the tree. This is used to pull the safety rope up to and through the karabiner on the wire rope.

Guide to risk for your risk assessment:

Fall from height is guaranteed so belay used

Falling crates all to wear safety hats

Spectators to stay out side roped area
